HISTORY OF "HERRINGBONE

Parquet flooring is made up of short wooden battens that are slotted together in a geometric mosaic. This gives a decorative flooring effect that is both beautiful and long lasting.

Also known as herringbone flooring, parquet flooring first became popular in 17th century France. It was initially used in manor houses as well as public buildings such as schools and factories. Then in the late 1600s, parquet floors were installed into the French royal palace at Versailles. Instead of the traditional squares of parquetry, the new "parquet de Versailles" designed for King Louis XIV laid large squares on the bias, creating a pattern of diamonds with further squares interlaced within them.



Parquet floors remained popular through to the 1930s when wall-to-wall carpet became the latest trend. And so many parquet floors remained hidden from view until the late 20th century when homeowners started to re-discover the beautiful vintage floors that lay underneath their carpets.

Thankfully, today's parquet flooring is less exclusive and less expensive than it used to be, and is now a popular form of flooring for all sorts of homes.



Unsurprisingly, the royal approval for parquet flooring made it a highly fashionable trend for those who could afford it. Aristocrats across France commissioned new parquetry patterns for their own chateaux, which included the parquets of Chantilly and Aremberg as well as the herringbone, marquetry and mosaic parquets that remain popular today.

The intricate wooden patterns were a popular replacement for marble floors as it required less maintenance. However this original form of parquet flooring was very expensive and took great skill to create and so installing parquet flooring became an exclusive demonstration of wealth.





FEATURING: GOODRICH FEATHER OAK

Modern design aficionado and writer of the popular interiors blog Design Hunter, Helen chose Feather Oak from Woodpecker's Goodrich collection for her new living room renovation. Opting for the traditional and hugely popular herringbone pattern, Helen explains why she made that selection.

"We looked at a lot of samples before eventually deciding on the Feather Oak parquet from Woodpecker's Goodrich collection. When we first began thinking about how we would design the space we were originally drawn to lighter white toned woods but after seeing a sample section of the Feather Oak laid out we changed our mind. It's a lovely soft, mid toned colour with a slightly grey finish, but was still light enough for the clean, modern look we wanted to achieve.

Chevron designs are very popular at the moment and they can look great, particularly if you want to achieve a strong, contemporary look, but we weren't sure this type of pattern would work for us. Our living room is long, rather than square, as it was originally two smaller rooms that were knocked into one. We felt that a chevron pattern might visually accentuate the length of the room and make it feel narrower by leading the eye in a single direction.

Conversely, the traditional parquet pattern we chose encourages the eye to travel around the room in a more even manner. This is a clevel little design trick that really worked for us – I think it makes the space feel wider than a more linear pattern might have done."







I think the finished result is absolutely fantastic and with running symmetry, it really complements the contours of the space"







JUNIPER HOMES, REDLAND COURT GIRLS SCHOOL







FINISHING TOUCHES

Matching Trims

All of our floors come with a full suite of matching trims to seamlessly finish off any doorway or transition

TWIN TRIM

Also called a 'T-bar' or 'expansion', the twin profile is used to cover the expansion gap between two floors of equal height, providing a neat finish at a doorway, or serving as a room divider.



SEMI RAMP TRIM

Where two surfaces meet but the difference in height is slight, a semi-ramp profile is the solution. They are ideal where your wood floor transitions to carpet.



RAMP TRIM

Where one surface meets another at uneven heights, a ramp profile is used. Typically, they bridge the gap between vinyl and wood flooring. They are also called 'reducers' or 'adapters'.



END TRIM

This profile is commonly used for inset mat wells, as well as where wood flooring meets a patio door. They're also called 'edge', 'square edge' or 'end stop' profiles.



COLOUR MATCHING

In addition to our natural oak floors, all our stained wood floors have a trim colour to complement, allowing an elegant transition between different floor surfaces.

We have very careful selection processes in place to ensure that all our wood trims fully complement our flooring range. However, do be aware that like the flooring, trims are subject to natural colour variation and may not appear to match the flooring exactly.
